#### Grade 1

- Math games, especially La barque des Monstres for addition & subtraction, have been a hit!
- RTI (Structured Literacy block) begins on Tuesday, November 8th. Each child will be working at their own "good-fit" level
- Students are taking turns being the "SUPER VEDETTE DE LECTURE" each week as we introduce a new sound. They are excited to be filmed & enjoy watching each other's videos
- Upcoming math concepts are: skip counting, lines, plane figures & 3-D shapes. Students are enjoying Remembrance Day writing & art activities

## Grade 2

- Halloween was a huge hit with the kids! They loved the assembly & our open door stations Friday afternoon
- Mme Malone's kids surprised her dressed up as minions on Monday! They had been planning it for weeks, she was so surprised!
- We just finished our first big evaluations in math & french, the kids worked super hard in preparation!
- We started our project in writing on les petits moments. We kicked it off with a children's book that the kids loved, & now they are writing their own petit Moment

## Phys. Ed.

- Cycle 1 Locomotion unit is coming to the end with evaluations & Halloween activities. Most games have been listening games as this adjusts to their present level
- Manipulative skills & station work will be the next focus
- Leadership students are learning to connect with the kindergarteners & to keep things fun

students will continue to explore quarter & eighth notes. K4 & K5 will be
working on tempo (fast & slow)

- There are 115 students registered for regular before & after school programs as of November 10th
- We continue to have our morning daycare outdoors. If we need to be indoors
  due to weather, we stay in the gym & the daycare room
- Hot lunches continue to be provided twice a week by Merenda
- Thank you again to Home & School for starting pizza lunches, it is enjoyed by all the students
- We continue to be outdoors as much as possible, all of our regular programming takes place outside, we bring toys, arts & crafts & everything outside. We go for walks in the woods & spend some of our afternoons in Heights Park
- We continue to have families register for daycare services & we remind parents that it takes 2-weeks notice for the changes to take place

- We ask that parents label their children's items as the Lost & Found is starting to fill up again rather quickly
