#### <u>H&S</u>

- Update on ECA Fees
  - After School Activities
    - Hip Hop Jr 33 students registered Sr 17 = \$1000 for H&S
    - Chess 27 students registered fall session = \$440 for H&S
    - Karate: Jr 29 registered Sr 20 = \$800 for H&S
    - Total = \$2240 for fall session
  - Price Change for Hip Hop (previously approved in June)
    - Was originally presented at \$130 but we wanted all the activities to be the same price as well as the same length of time (8 weeks for 1 hour), therefore the price has been changed to \$200 (\$20 going to H&S) <u>Activity Fundraiser</u>

- The change in the price for Hip Hop was approved unanimously, via a motion moved by T. Rudolph & seconded by M. Edwards
  - Halloween Dance at JR
    - Taking place on October 27th from 6:00-8:30
    - Same format as last year: DJ, animator (this year with some activities in the gym like coloring, touchy feely games, maybe cookie decorating) <u>Halloween Dance</u>
  - Auction Nov 27<sup>th</sup>

## Daycare Approvals Required by Governing Board Daycare Late Pick-Up Fees

- There has been a change made on page 8 in the Daycare Rules & Regulations, Late Pick-up Fees

- The Ministry of Education recently authorized the LBPSB to adopt a 2023-2024 deficit budget (with a 2024-2025 recovery plan to return to a balanced situation)
- As a result, Council approved the 2023-2024 Operating Budget anticipating revenues of \$366,114,387 & expenses of \$368,880,231 which represents a \$2,765,844 deficit
